

Seminar Display Room

Many questions were asked about the beautiful shawl knitted by Moya Baker of the Wagga Wagga Machine knitters. She first saw it demonstrated by Mary James. She then found it again in a magazine notes written by Susanna Lewis. Here are her instructions.

Using card 77 with Deco on 4 C.O. 60 stitches with racking cast on. I used 2 colour combinations but you can experiment and use 1 colour or 3 or 4 combinations. You knit 60 rows N/AX with Deco 4 in all. I knitted 40 rows main colour and 20 rows contrast colour. After knitting required rows transfer stitches to back bed and knit 1 row

N/N then with long enough thread and 2 eye tool thread yarn through back bed stitches and take off machine pulling thread up tight to form motif.

You can make a square motif by casting on 40 stitches and working 80 rows finishing as explained above. Also an octagonal motif with 80 stitches and 80 rows.
