

MINI HAT EGG COSIES

Machine

Standard gauge

Yarn

4 ply wool/wool blend – sock yarn and multi coloured yarns look the best.

Materials

A boiled egg + an egg cup

Instructions

Note: Shaping is achieved by changing tension.

'e' wrap 38 needles

Tension 10, knit 4 rows

Tension 9, knit 4 rows

Tension 8, knit 6 rows

Tension 7, knit 6 rows



Hook alternate stitches onto the adjacent needles so that 2 stitches are on each alternate

needle. (19 needles)

Tension 6, knit 2 rows,

Tension 5, knit 2 rows

Thread yarn through all stitches and remove from the machine.

Thread the yarn through the open stitches for a second time and mattress stitch the seam

until the last 2 cm and then continue sewing the seam on the other side as this part will roll

and the purl side of the knitting will show.

Add a pom-pon.

Place the mini hat on top of a boiled egg.
