

Baby's Bootee by Jan Adams



This bootee has seam centre front,
turn-down top and holes for ribbon tie.

Materials: 4ply baby yarn and length of ribbon.

Any standard gauge knitting machine with ribber.

COR: Cast-on 47st. & knit 3 circular rows.

T.5: Rib 24 rows.

Transfer stitches. to main bed.

Transfer every second st. to next needle (ribbon holes), bring all
needles to working position.

T.7: Knit 2 rows. Inc. each end alt. rows, 5 times.(57sts.)

Knit 18 rows. Dec. 3sts each end, knit 1 row.

Last row: COL: Dec. 3sts.left of "0", needles to NWP.,
cast off until "0", dec. 3 sts right of "0" and cast off
remaining stitches.

First dec. gives a round toe and dec. in middle gives a
"heel turn".
