

FLOATING SQUIGGLES

Machine

Standard gauge using every second needle (If using a bulky adjust tension)

Yarn

Avril Silk / Stainless steel, and Habu Nerimaki (cotton slub) (From Dairing Yarns)

NOTE: The stainless steel yarn holds interesting memory characteristics. The cotton yarn does not weigh it down used so sparingly, and it shows off the beauty of the thick and thin slub yarn.



Instructions

Cast on 41 stitches

Tension 10 Stocking stitch

Use the stainless yarn for every row and do not remove from the feeder. Use the cotton slub every 3rd row. Remove at the end of each row used but do not break off the yarn

Knit approximately 300 rows Cast off
